Semester Description:

This course helps prepare graduate students in the history department for entrance into the higher education postdoctoral fellowship marketplace. Students will learn how to find employment opportunities. They will produce a portfolio of materials—research statements, teaching philosophies, writing samples, sample syllabi, and cover letters—that they will be able to use in their applications and they will prepare a research presentation (“job talk”) for prospective employers. Lastly, students will prepare for and undergo a mock job interview and give their mock job talk.
